




Building Beautiful - Whatever The Scale

Where possible, the timber used in our projects is sourced either locally or from sustainably managed forests where there is an active strategy of replanting and habitat regeneration. All this ensures our structures are safe, secure and sustainable.



 - Blackboards and painting walls



- A multi-level play structure with surrounding ground play that references many of the architectural gems in the surrounding area
- In addition to the play, the design included a toilet block, F&B unit and giant pergola - under which parents can sit, relax and enjoy a coffee whilst their kids explore
- Includes many quirky unique-to-Beaulieu items such as the peaky portraits, an elaborate ground play loop with bespoke wooden cars, and a giant twisting tube slide from the peak of the clock tower!



OVERVIEW

- A brand new adventure play park set in the working Victorian town of Blists Hill in Ironbridge
- This project included a 3-storey mine building set into a giant sandpit with multi-level sand-play, multi-level walkways, clamber walls and zip lines
- A key feature is the giant coal chute tube slide that descends down into the gorge leading you to the saw mill, another 3-storey play structure with bungee maze, a musical organ and multiple ladders
- Situated within a UNESCO World Heritage Site



- Design aimed to provide creative and challenging play for all abilities. A place where children can unleash their imagination and collaborate in new ways
- Varied level decks take the children up into the trees and into nature
- The design is packed with features from high-level walkways, slides, a fireman's pole, lookout nest and talking tubes, also providing reflective spaces for a quiet moment during the busy school day



OVERVIEW

- Two bespoke treehouses called the Woodland Dens were built tucked into the woodland in Whitlingham broad campsite. They are designed to sleep 4-5 and have every luxury you could ask for between king-size double beds, cooking facilities, wardrobes, bathrooms and lounging hammocks
- The Dens are built into a steep slope meaning that whilst you enter at ground level as you walk through the den, through the double height lounge area with fully glazed truss and out onto the covered deck you are stood up within the beautiful tree canopy of the surrounding woodland



- Tree top adventure maze centred around a large treehouse perched among the trees
- Play elements include V-walkways, jungle bridges, crawl tunnels, rope bridges and a multi-faceted climbing wall
- Wheelchair access into the central treehouse via a series of ramped walkways that climb into the trees canopy



- Phase 1 & 2 of a wider adventure play scheme included an 8m tall play tower, directly inspired by the nearby Appleton water tower, as well as a treetop walkway with jungle bridge
- It also included a ruined church play structure inspired by the nearby ruin of St Mary, complete with giant climbing wall, jungle nets, a firemans pole and sandbox with chutes and buckets
- The toddler play area comprises of small ornate buildings containing musical instruments and wonky mirrors interlinked by walkways and ramps

OVERVIEW

- The Plotter's Forest is an adventure play ground set in the heart of Raby Castle's Christmas tree plantation. This magical setting is home to two main play structures inter-linked by tree-top walkways, log scrambles, climbing walls and a fireman's pole
- Neville's Gateway Fort forms the main entrance into the playground and holds peaky portraits, xylophone, a net floor, ladders and a sky high tunnel
- The Plotter's Tower holds a towering net chimney that spans it's three levels. From the top level you can take it's giant tube slide that curls round the tower back down to the ground
- A small toddler play area is located at the top of the park next to the F&B unit comprising of two small forts, connecting walkway and slide



OVERVIEW

- This aerial adventure play sees three huge decks wrap around the magnificent red woods of Dumfries House interlinked by rope and jungle bridges and a net tunnel to form a magical adventure play ground
- Further walkways lead to a slide deck with bespoke pairs game and twin racing slides incorporated into the huge slope the playground sits on
- An additional multi-level tower completes this woodland wonderland with ground play, a climbing wall, net walls and a huge twisting tube slide accessed by the giant spiral staircase

OVERVIEW

- Knights Stronghold is a towering 3 level fort housing clamber nets, spiral staircases, secret rooms and tunnels. The fort is enclosed by the accessible fort wall walkways and backed to it's rear by The Great Gloriette inspired by the great fire of 1665 at Leeds Castle which contains the racing zip lines
- This gigantic playground is only accessed/exited by the fort's drawbridge giving parents piece of mind as they let their children run wild and explore

- Set inside a large agricultural barn and silo this adventure play includes a Roman fort and Pictish roundhouse, inspired by the neighbouring history of Hadrian's Wall
- Packed with play features Walby Farm includes foam ball cannons, giant slides, firemans pole, clamber nets, wobbly bridges, crawl tunnels and climbing walls
- A large portion of this play space is wheelchair accessible with the ramp wrapping round the silo walls leading into the Mile Castle within the main play barn

- Eureka! is focused around STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts and maths) and is designed to bring these subjects to life through fun, exploration, experimentation and curiosity
- The Climbing Tree is a hero exhibit that sits within the entrance void spanning 2 floors
- The tree offers multiple levels of explorative play as you clamber up it's branches
- The Field Mouse Nest is a play offering for the under 5's, children can clamber up the steps into the nest and discover the fieldmouse curled on the floor before heading down the toddler slide

- The first phase of a two phase play ground saw 'The West Lodge' and toddler play realised in Coombe Abbey Park
- Inspired by architecture in the wider park the lodge houses multiple play elements such as a climbing wall, net tunnel, slide, ladder and talking tubes
- The toddler play offers the under 5's a multitude of discovery experiences with crawl tunnels, log steps, elevated walkways and a toddler zip line

- Peskador Leska translated as The Fishermans Swing was inspired by local cornish culture and included a large fishing boat with clamber net and slide, wobble board fishes, multi-user swings, stormy sea stick mazes and rolling grass mounds

- The HMS Resolution Adventure was inspired by the 18th century ship captained by Robert Manners and offers a glimpse in to the historical tales to come from Belvoir Castle
- This play structure acts as the entrance to the playground that will be built in two phases and houses a whole host of play elements such as crawl spaces, climbing walls, port holes and a thrilling zip line that launches you off the rear of the ship to fly through the surrounding woodland
- The ship leads through into the main play space which houses the mini toddler fort and The Castle Maze complete with giant tube slide, climbing walls, mini chute and spiral staircase



- The park is based around the concept of spy's with Burghley House being built by William Cecil, the country's first Chief Spymaster

- A large portion of the park is designed with accessibility in mind. Wide pathways, a sensory wall, accessible platforms in the lower levels of the towers and accessible lookout points across the gorge mean everyone can come and play together
